

PRIVACY POLICY OF THE WELDONE APPLICATION

1. Who is the Controller of your data?

The controller of your personal data (as a User creating an Account) is **WELDONE Łukasz Musiał**, with its registered office in Gliwice (44-100), ul. Robotnicza 2 lok. 1-006, Poland, Tax Identification Number (NIP): 6312698901 (hereinafter: the "Controller"). You can contact the Controller via e-mail at: [YOUR COMPANY EMAIL ADDRESS].

2. What data do we collect and for what purpose?

We collect only the data necessary to provide the B2B service (SaaS):

- **Registration and billing data:** First and last name, company name, Tax Identification Number (NIP), e-mail address, phone number, and registered office address. These are necessary to create an Account, provide support services, and issue VAT invoices (legal basis: performance of a contract – Art. 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, and legal/tax obligations – Art. 6(1)(c) of the GDPR).
- **Usage data (logs):** IP address, browser information, date and time of login. These serve to ensure the security of the Application and to diagnose errors (legal basis: legitimate interest of the Controller – Art. 6(1)(f) of the GDPR).

3. Data Processing Agreement (Data entered into the Application)

1. As part of using the Application, the User may enter personal data of their clients (e.g., contact details on quotes/offers).
2. In relation to this data, the User is the Data Controller, and WELDONE acts solely as the Data Processor.
3. Acceptance of the Application's Terms of Service is equivalent to concluding a Data Processing Agreement. We undertake to process this data exclusively for the purpose of providing the Application's infrastructure and we do not use it for our own purposes.

4. Who do we share the data with?

Your data may be transferred exclusively to trusted entities with whom we cooperate to ensure the proper functioning of the Application. These include:

- Cloud infrastructure and server providers (e.g., AWS).

- Online payment operators (to handle subscriptions).
- The accounting office servicing our company.

We do not sell or share data for marketing purposes with third parties.

5. How long do we keep the data?

We store data for the duration of the Subscription (holding an Account in the Application). After deleting the Account, the data will be deleted within 30 days, except for billing data (invoices), which we are obliged to keep for 5 years in accordance with tax law regulations.

6. Your rights (GDPR)

You have the right to:

- Access your data and receive a copy of it.
- Rectify (correct) your data.
- Delete your data (the "right to be forgotten") or restrict its processing.
- Lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO in Poland) or your relevant local supervisory authority if you believe that we process your data unlawfully.

7. Cookies

The Application uses essential cookies to maintain the User's login session, as well as basic analytical tools to improve the operation of the system (e.g., error tracking). By using the Application, you agree to their use.
